### **Bristol Transit Buses/Para Transit**

### **Garbage Pick-Up**

All garbage collection will remain on a regular schedule on Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>.

### **Parks and Recreation**

Slater Center will be closed on Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>. All parks, shelters and Steele Creek Golf Course will maintain regular business hours during the holiday.

State Street Farmers Market will not be open on Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, but will re-open on Saturday, July 7<sup>th</sup>.
