The last four singles Chris Young has released have all hit #1 on the charts, including "Tomorrow" and the smash hit "Gettin' You Home," a song that earned him his first-ever Grammy nomination. All signs are pointing skyward as NEON debuts at # 4 on the all genre Billboard Top 200 chart. "Young plays over 150 concert dates a year and Bristol, the Birthplace of Country Music is lucky enough to secure one of those dates", said Darlene Cole, Venues Manager for the city. "Country music is drawing a much younger audience. I think that there is a direct cause and effect in that the average country music artist is in their 20's.
