Suits for delinquent 2012 taxes to be filed by city

The City of Bristol is, as required by city charter, filing suit on March 31, 2014, in Chancery Court for collection of delinquent 2012 City Taxes. “This is the normal process the city goes through in an effort to collect delinquent taxes. We are making every effort to allow people to clear up their accounts prior to going to court. We realize there are times when maybe the taxes were just overlooked or people moved and didn’t get that year’s tax statement. There could be all kinds of reasons they haven’t been paid,” said Tara Musick, Director of Finance.

Until the filing of the suits, taxes may be paid in the Finance Department located in City Hall at 801 Anderson Street. The Finance Department will only accept cash, money orders, or checks. Currently the office does not except credit or debit cards for tax payments.

If you are not sure of the amount owed, detailed information may be obtained by contacting Property tax staff at 423-989-5500 or email at propertytax@bristoltn.org. In addition to the current amount owed, additional penalties and costs will be imposed after March 31st and will be required to be paid to Chancery Court in Room 239 in the Justice Center at 801 Anderson Street.
