A temporary mobile vending unit is defined in Section 219 of the Bristol Tennessee Zoning Ordinance as: Temporary Mobile Vending Units, including but not limited to: truck, trailer, cart or similar unit; may be permitted provided that: (1) They are located on commercially zoned private property; (2) have written consent from the property owner; (3) obtain appropriate licensing required; and (4) are removed from the authorized operation locations in permitted zones when not in use and between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. This definition does not include vehicles operating during a special event. Such a business may only be conducted in accordance with Section 219 of the Bristol Tennessee Zoning Ordinance, and provided a temporary mobile vending unit permit has been issued.

A temporary mobile vending unit permit may be revoked when it is determined that the conditions of its issuance are not being met.

Criteria for issuance of a Temporary Mobile Vending Unit Permit are listed below:

- 1. The Temporary Mobile Vending Unit is located on commercially zoned private property.**
- 2. A business license has been paid for and applied for.**
- 3. Applicant must have written consent from the property owner.**

4. Applicant must have all appropriate licensing requirements from the Tennessee Department of Health.
5. I understand there may be no signage, other than a sandwich board.
6. I agree not to create noise, vibration, glare, smoke, fumes, odors, or electrical interference to the normal senses beyond the property lines of the lot.
7. I agree that all parking associated with the Temporary Mobile Vending Unit shall occur on the private property premises.
8. I understand that the Temporary Mobile Vending Unit must comply with all conditions of the permit issuance or suffer revocation as provided by the ordinance.
9. I understand that a Temporary Mobile Vending Unit Permit will be revoked should it be determined that the conditions of its issuance are not being met.
10. I understand that the Temporary Mobile Vending Unit must be removed from the authorized operation locations in permitted zones when not in use and between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
11. I certify that I have read and understand each of the Temporary Mobile Vending Unit Permit limitations and I will comply with all limitations.
