Item A: MPO Resolution 15-13
Amendment #10 to the FY 2014-2017 Transportation Improvement Program


Background:

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) documents how Federal funds will be expended on transportation projects within the MPO's Metropolitan Planning Area. Amendment #10 represents Federal funding programmed for reconstruction of Route 11 (Lee Highway) from 100 feet west of the I-81 south bound on/off ramps to 75 feet west of Island Road in Bristol, Virginia (UPC 105309). The amendment includes Federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funds, as well as State funding, Revenue Sharing, and Advanced Construction funds.

Please note the balance of the Route 11 improvements at the Falls retail development, from Island Road to Blevins Boulevard (UPC 105308), is funded by State Revenue Sharing and does not include Federal dollars. As such, MPO/TIP approval is not required (see project map).

Recommendation:

Executive Board consideration for adoption of Resolution 15-13 is requested, approving Amendment # 10 to the FY 2014-2017 Transportation Improvement Program.

AMENDMENT SUMMARY: Amendment #10 represents Urban System funding for reconstruction and added capacity to Route 11 in Bristol, Virginia from 100 feet west of Interstate 81 south bound on/off ramps to 75 feet west of Island Road (VDOT UPC Number 105309). Project funding is allocated for Fiscal Year 2016-2017. The project is locally administered with Federal oversight.

A Resolution Amending the Fiscal Year 2014-2017 Transportation Improvement Program

WHEREAS, in accordance with Federal requirements of the U. S. Department of Transportation, the Metropolitan Planning Organization is required to maintain a Transportation Improvement Program of Federally funded projects; and

WHEREAS, State and local agencies involved with transportation planning for the Bristol Urban Area cooperatively developed the Fiscal Year 2014-2017 Transportation Improvement Program; adopted by Bristol Tennessee/Virginia Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization on December 10, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Amendment #10 incorporates funding for the Route 11 (Lee Highway) reconstruction at Interstate 81, Exit 5 (UPC 105309) in the Bristol FY 2014-2017 Transportation Improvement Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Executive Board of the Bristol Tennessee/Virginia Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization as follows:

That the Bristol Tennessee/Virginia Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization does hereby approve Amendment #10, attached and incorporated hereinafter, to the Bristol Urban Area Fiscal Year 2014-2017 Transportation Improvement Program.

METROPOLITAN TRANSPORTATION PLANNING PROCESS CERTIFICATION

In accordance with 23 CFR 450.334, the Bristol Tennessee/Virginia Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization hereby certifies, with concurrence of the Tennessee Department of Transportation and Virginia Department of Transportation, that the transportation planning process is addressing the major issues in the metropolitan planning area and is being conducted in accordance with all applicable requirements of:

- (1) 23 USC 134, 49 USC 5303 (Highways and Transit);
- (2) In non-attainment and maintenance areas, sections 174 and 176 (c) and (d) of the Clean Air Act, as amended 942 U.S.C. 7504, 7506 (c) and (d) and 40 CFR part 93;
- (3) Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended (42 U.S.C. 2000d-1) and 49 CFR part 21;
- (4) 49 U.S.C. 5332, prohibiting discrimination, on the basis of race, creed, national origin, sex or age in employment or business opportunity;
- (5) Section 1101 (b) of the MAP-21 (Pub. L 112-141) and 49 CFR part 26 regarding the involvement of disadvantaged business enterprises in USDOT funded projects;
- (6) 23 CFR part 230, regarding the implementation of an equal employment opportunity program on Federal and Federal-aid highway construction contracts;
- (7) Provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101 et. Seq.) and 49 CFR parts 27, 37, and 38;
- (8) The Older Americans Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. 6101), prohibiting discrimination on the basis of age in programs or activities receiving Federal financial assistance;
- (9) Section 324 of title 23 U.S.C. regarding the prohibition of discrimination based on gender; and
- (10) Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794) and 49 CFR part 27 regarding discrimination against individuals with disabilities.
