Call to order - At approximately 5:00 pm on January 16, 2019, Mr. Kistner, Chairman of the Beer Board for the Beer Board for the City of Bristol, Tennessee, called the meeting to order in the conference room of the Ewell L. Easley Municipal Bldg., located at 104 Eighth St., Bristol Tennessee.

Review of Minutes - Board members reviewed minutes from the October 17, 2018 meeting and the minutes were approved as read.

NEW BUSINESS

The Cascade Draft House, 828 State St., Bristol, TN: Mr. Spence Flagg appeared before the board to request an on-premises permit. Lt. Brown advised the board that the application is in order and fees have been paid. Lt. Brown stated that the location was still under construction and will require a final inspection. Mr. Flagg advised that he is familiar with the process of serving and selling beer and he projects the business to be open in April. Mr. Turner then made a motion to approve the application pending the final inspection. Mr. Greeson seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously by the board.

The Sportsman, 1403 Bluff City Hwy, Bristol, TN: Lt. Brown advised the board that the Sportsman has surrendered their license due to the establishment closing. The owner of the Speedway Inn will be applying for a permit for the same location and will appear at the February meeting.

OLD BUSINESS – The board previously requested that City Council be made aware of concerns regarding the use of armbands for alcohol sales during special events. Lt. Brown advised that the concerns will be discussed at the February council meeting. Chief Wade provided a list of the establishments that use armbands and doorman/markings upon entry. Machiavelli's, The Paramount, Bloom Café, and the Beer Festival event issue armbands. The American Legion, Country Club Bar and Grill, The Angry Italian, Stateline Bar and Grill, and Knights of Columbus utilize a doorman to check ids and mark accordingly.

With no further business on the agenda, Mr. Kistner proposed the board elect the Chairman and Vice Chairman for 2019. Mr. Ketron nominated Mr. Kistner for Chairman. Mr. Turner seconded the motion and nominated Mr. Walden for Vice Chairman. The members of the board passed both motions; Mr. Kistner as Chairman and Mr. Walden as Vice Chairman. Mr. Kistner advised members that the next meeting will be held on February 20, 2019. With no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
