

**MINUTES OF THE CITY OF BRISTOL, TENNESSEE
CITY COUNCIL WORK SESSION**

February 23, 2021

The City of Bristol, Tennessee City Council Work Session was called to order by Mayor Mahlon Luttrell on February 23, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. The meeting was held electronically via Zoom.

Present were Mayor Mahlon Luttrell, Vice Mayor Vince Turner, Councilwoman Margaret Feierabend, Councilman Chad Keen, and Councilwoman Lea Powers.
