Today the City of Bristol, Tennessee held a Grand Opening ribbon-cutting event at the new CareHere Employee Health & Wellness Clinic. The new facility will provide access to primary and preventive healthcare to the City of Bristol employees and their dependents, covered by the City's health plan. The new CareHere Employee Health and Wellness Clinic is the launch of a collaborative partnership by the City of Bristol, Tennessee and Tennessee-based industry pioneer, CareHere. "We are very eager to get our employees into see the facility and participate in the new program.
